# **OTHER SPECIAL OFFERS**

Other than the usual, British School of Kampala offers a variety of Level 3 BTEC qualifications. Broadly, BTEC qualifications prepare one for a specific practical career. The BTECs revolve around coursework and very often, work experience too.

A question we get a lot at BSK is "Are BTECs easier to do than A-Levels"? Do not choose a BTEC expecting an easy life! The top grade – D or Distinction is treated as equivalent to an A\* at A level and the bottom grade – P or pass – is equivalent to an E (a pass at A level). In a BTEC, due to the continuous assessment methods, you will also have to work very steadily throughout your course. To figure out whether one would find BTEC easier than A levels, think about what works for you personally in terms of learning and assessment style, and what motivates the learner?

If you are ready to decide your career direction or prefer practical learning to lots of theory or do better in continual assessments, then a BTEC at BSK could be a good fit for you. We are excited to announce that we are in the final stages of getting approval to deliver Level 1 BTEC programmes for only the secondary OLC students.

- WhatsApp: Upon a child's admission, every parent is added to their child's year WhatsApp group. This forum is used for news and reminders throughout the year. The policy is that, the school sends a message and no individual opinions are shared on the group. For any response to a school message, it should be in boxed to the sender. We request that this is respected so that we reduce the congestion our responses create.
